- 1.2* The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' (available at [reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf \(watersportverbond.nl\)](#)) will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) 62.2, 64.1, 64.2, 65.2, 66, E6.5 will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.

- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6* Every competitor who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

- 10.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 10.2 Boats shall be available for equipment inspection from 08.30h to 10.00h on 14-10-2023
- 10.3 Boats may be inspected at any time.

13 COURSES

- 13.1 The courses to be sailed will be as follows:
Upwind Downwind with 3-4 upwind marks (each mark will have a different colour) and 1 spreader and a downwind gate (red marks)

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 14.1 If (a) boat(s) break(s) a rule of the RRS and it does not take a one turn penalty immediately, the protest committee is entitled to penalize a boat by instructing her to take a two turn penalty including two tacks and two gybes. This changes E7 (b).
- 14.2 Decisions of the Jury will be final as provided in RRS70.5a

15 SCORING

- 15.1* Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 15.2 The heat management system (HMS) shall apply unless the number of participants is less than 24. A copy will be available at the race office.
- 15.3 RRS 64.3 is changed by HMS so that redress can be given by assigning a place with appropriate points.
- 15.4 RRS 90.3 (e) is applicable

21 DATA PROTECTION

21.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

22.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

23 INSURANCE

23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

24* PRIZES

The RNWA supplies for the winning boat a blue pennant and a medal.

Other prizes will be given as follows: 1st , 2nd and 3rd

For the best Dutch competitor there is the KOM challenge cup.

Participation awards will be given to all competitors

25 FURTHER INFORMATION

25.1 On Saturday 14 October 2023 a Captains dinner will be organised for participants and invites at the R&Zv "GOUDA ". The cost for the dinner is € 22,50 / person. 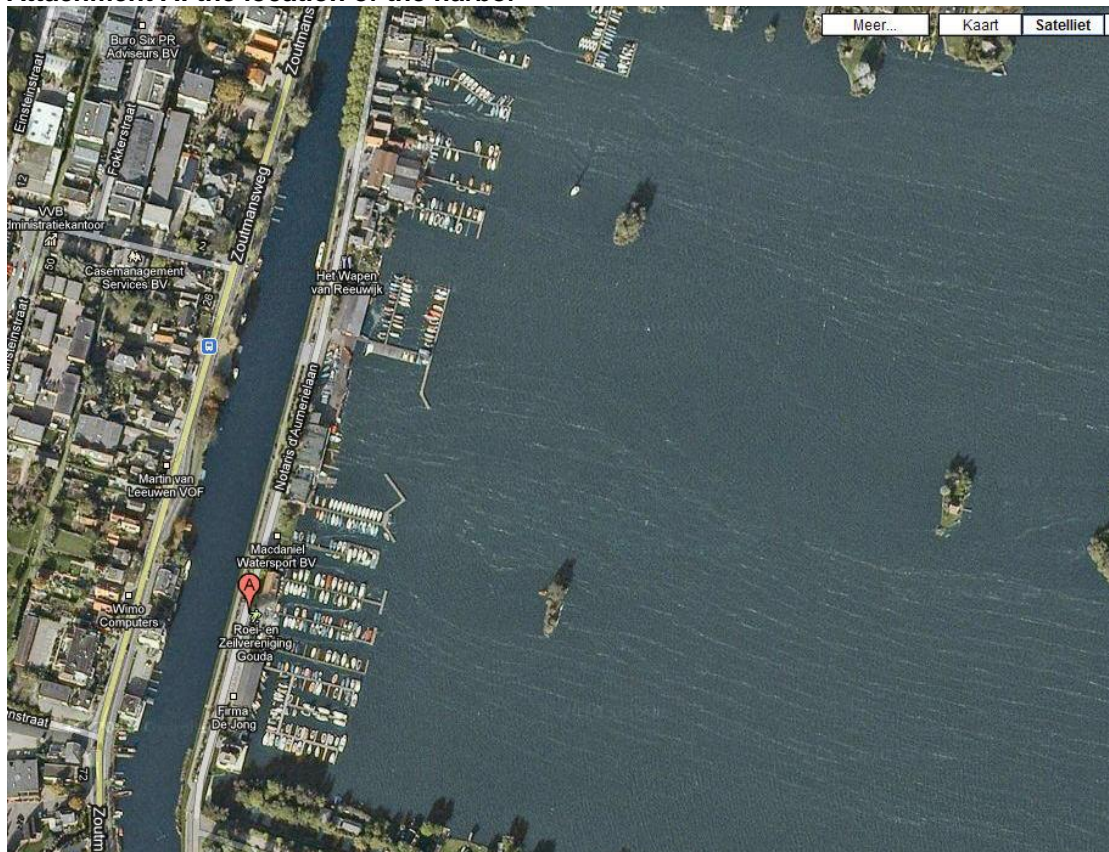
