For a successful registration and subsequent participation in the regatta compliance with the class rules are mandatory.

## **13 COURSES**

**13.1** The courses to be sailed will be as follows:  
Upwind Downwind with 3 - 4 upwind marks of which 2 will be the upwind gate and a downwind gate.

## **14 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**14.1** If (a) boat(s) break(s) a rule of the RRS and it does not take a one turn penalty immediately, the PRO and his assistants are entitled to penalize a boat by instructing her to take a two turn penalty including two tacks and two gybes. This changes E7 (b).

**14.2** Decisions of the PRO and his assistants will be final as provided in RRS70.5a

## **15 SCORING**

**15.1\*** Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

**15.2** The heat management system (HMS ) shall apply unless the number of participants is less than 24. A copy will be available at the race office.

**615.3** RRS 64.3 is changed by HMS so that redress can be given by assigning a place with appropriate points.

## **21 DATA PROTECTION**

- 21.1** By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

## **22 RISK STATEMENT**

- 22.1** RRS 3 has a text that is applicable to big boats (1:1 scale). Modified for RC sailing the following applies: The responsibility for a competitor's decision to participate in a race, or continue to race is his/ hers alone. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that RC sailing has aspects that can have risks. These risks may include slipping and falling, falling into the water at the racing area or jetty, falling overboard from a rescue boat, etc. As an extra precaution is anyone who uses a rescue boat obliged to wear a life vest.
- 22.2** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **23 INSURANCE**

- 23.1** Each competitor shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

## **24\* PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> , 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Participation awards will be given to all competitors
