1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* .Incl Appendix E
The Prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at [World Sailing - Racing Rules of Sailing](#)
- 1.2 The '[Rules for \(Open\) Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding](#)' will apply.
The Equipment Rules of Sailing, the IRSA Championship Regulations, the Heat Management System, the IRSA Addendum Q 2013 and the IRSA System for Reduced Protest Hearings (SYRPH) version 2013 will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) E7(b)., will be changed, see 14.2.
The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.5 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all registered boats of the **IOM** class.

- 4.4 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Entry fee will be €70.00.



4.5 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Maximum number of boats is 36.

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fee is €65.00. This needs to be transferred before 12-10-2026 see 4.2
Entry fee includes a lunch on Saturday and Sunday.

5.2 The entry fee is non-refundable, except for the event being cancelled by the organizing authority or if the entry is rejected under RRS 76.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 14.1 If a boat(s) breaks a rule of the RRS and does not take(s) a one-turn penalty immediately, the protest committee is entitled to penalize a boat by instructing her to take a two-turns penalty including two tacks and two gybes. This changes E7(b).
14.2 RRS Appendix P applies.

15 SCORING

- 15.1 The scoring system is as follows: Appendix A
15.2* Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
15.3 The heat management system (HMS) shall apply unless the number of participants is less than 17. A copy will be available at the race office.
15.4 RRS 90.3(e) applies, only for the final results.

21 RISK STATEMENT

- 21.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
21.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.



22 INSURANCE

- 22.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

23 PRIZES

- 23.1*** The RNWA supplies for the winning boat or team a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats or crews (there will be no extra medals available for changes in the crew during the event).
- 23.2** Other prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place.
